


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Introduction





Board of Patrons



1. TCS "CGP" – Green School Program

Flash floods, heatwaves, droughts, smog in winters, melting glaciers in the Karakorum, forest fires in summers, landslides in monsoon – all are causing massive displacements, food, and water crisis. To involve students in our effort to address climate change, we are commencing Pakistan's first Green School Program – GSP, in collaboration with World Wide Fund for Nature – WWF. Designed on yearly bases, it accommodates and teaches students of early, primary, middle, and secondary levels on indigenous environmental challenges with global dimensions. The program also offers opportunities to learn and implement creative ways to conserve and protect the environment through a compulsory subject on the theoretical aspect of the environment and mandatory participation in related projects and plantation drives.

2.TCS "IEP" – Innovative Entrepreneurship Program



Innovative Entrepreneurship Program – IEP is Pakistan's first comprehensive program offered by TCS to develop valuable skills for entrepreneurship in students. It forms an integral part of our curriculum. It will introduce students to the world of business and the impact they can make through their ideas while learning basic business terms and concepts. As technology becomes more ingrained in the everyday lives of our students, they are expected to be creative thinkers, active collaborators, and problem solvers. At TCS, we teach all of these essential skills of the 21st-century to make our students stand out in a highly competitive job market.

TCS has partnered up with well-known international organizations to provide necessary entrepreneurship education in Pakistan. Initially, students get training to improve their critical reasoning and presented gradually with more complex ideas of profit and loss, marketing strategy, and negotiation. To encourage students to design their business plans, they will be offered every year an opportunity to participate in an Entrepreneurship Summit. As the future workforce is more receptive to independent positions, TCS is keen on producing leaders and entrepreneurs in Pakistan.

We put forth 21st-century curriculum

We are fully aware of the knowledge and skills students are expected to have and display at different levels of education. At TCS, the curriculum is made flexible and responsive to changing technologies and market demands under the National Education Policy, keeping in view the standards of international curricula and the necessity of indigenous knowledge. We have excellent support of international bodies to implement our curriculum, making it absorbing and relevant to the 21st-century while inspiring at the same time our students to think on their feet with a hands-on activity approach facilitated by the experts. As standards play a significant part in education, TCS maintains a subscription of international as well as national standards aiming to become a global entity in providing quality education. These standards are reflected through a unique system that distinguishes TCS from mainstream schools. We are careful of the overall outlook of our Schools. Therefore, provide reasonable classroom sizes, engaging décor, small student-teacher ratio, career counseling, STEAM labs, training on entrepreneurship, modern textbooks, student-centered curriculum, and mandatory digital infrastructure. Our curriculum is divided into four levels of education.

1. TCS Early Years Curriculum - EYC

The Early Years Curriculum -EYC of TCS is a three-year foundational early education from Play-Group, Nursery year to Kindergarten level. The average age group for this qualification is 3-5 years. The focus is on introducing 21stcentury skills like creativity, critical thinking, and communication in the children with the help of the easy-toengage group and individual activities. The designated team for the EYC supports the curriculum with ageappropriate blended-learning tools and strategies to implement them. Children are exposed to the idea of personal independence, freedom to

initiate activities, and make choices. The environment reflects self-discipline and self-motivation and values each child as a unique individual with special skills and abilities. We educate children on the importance of spiritual enlightenment through practice and encourage character building in agreement with Islamic principles.

At TCS, we understand the inevitable aspect of maintaining an inclusive environment that acknowledges children from diverse families, cultural and religious backgrounds.
